Coronavirus Advice

Dear Brothers and Sisters

We are all aware of the need to care for each other and now especially now with Coronavirus in our country. We have received advice from the Archbishop, who has received information from the Commonwealth Department of Health and our own medical personnel, that we should immediately take appropriate precautions.

Working with the Wardens we are implementing the following:

1. Holy Communion

- a. There will be no common cup offered. Individual cups only.
- b. There will be no passing along of trays of bread.

So, for the time being, the bread will be served by a designated person to each of us individually.

All involved in preparing and distributing will need to have washed their hands with soap and water and dry with paper towel. Then use sanitiser as necessary.

2. Food – Morning Teas etc

It is important to ensure that food is not placed out in open plates so as to prevent the opportunity for it to be touched or breathed on.

So, food will need to be in containers and people served individually by a designated person.

All involved in preparing and distributing will need to have washed their hands with soap and water and dry with paper towel. Then use sanitiser as necessary.

3. Drink

We will be suspending self-serve Tea and Coffee. Designated people will pour the Tea , Coffee and milk as required for you.

All involved in preparing and distributing will need to have washed their hands with soap and water and dry with paper towel. Then use sanitiser as necessary.

4. Children's Ministry

We will be following the advice given to us which is to serve food and drink in a way that does not leave it open to be touched or breathed on. This means each child will be served individually with tongs.

All involved in preparing and distributing will need to have washed their hands with soap and water and dry with paper towel. Then use sanitiser as necessary.

5. General Advice

If you are not feeling well, especially with flu-like symptoms, do consider seriously stepping aside and not attend until you are feeling better. We are advised not to shake hands.

We need to be aware that touch and breath are the key ways these viruses are spread. We want to care for each other and especially those who are vulnerable health-wise.

We need to be in fervent prayer that the effects of the viruses might be restrained. Praying for those who are ill, wisdom for government and health authorities, that God would be gracious to us and limit the numbers who fall ill.

May God be merciful to our world that the virus may be contained and a vaccine quickly developed.
