Giving by Bank Transfer

There are two ways to give using bank transfer:

Use your bank's website or app to transfer money to the Church's account:

Account Name: Dapto Anglican Church Offertory Fund

BSB Number: 032686

Account Number: 301487

If you do not use a computer or have not used online banking, please fill in the Direct Debit Request form. This gives the church the authority to set up a recurring direct debit from your account. You give the Church the following information:

- your bank account details
amount you want to give
how often you want to give

Our Treasurer then sets up a recurring transfer as per your instructions. The Direct Debit Request form is available from the church office or on our website at dapto.church/giving.

Giving using Tithe.ly

The Tithe.ly app allows you to provide your gift using your credit card. You can also go to the Giving menu on our website (dapto.church/giving) and follow the instructions to set up a once-off or recurring gift to the church.

Giving using Offertory Envelopes

If you are not comfortable with using a bank transfer, you can collect a set of offertory envelopes from the office, or call the office on 4261 1001 and ask for a set to be delivered to you. Simply put your gift in the envelope and return it to the office. (Office Hours are 10:00am to 3:00pm – Monday to Friday).
