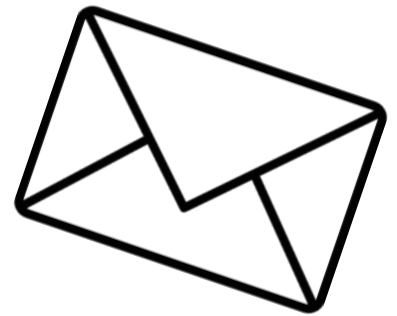
With the support of Peter, staff and Wardens, we began 6 weeks leave on Monday 16th March.

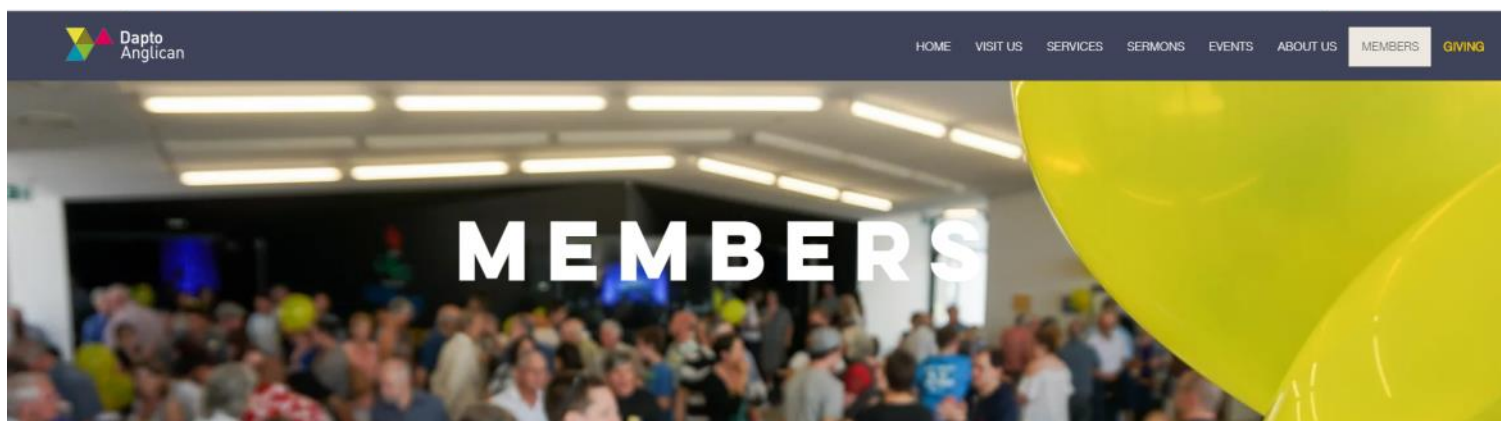
